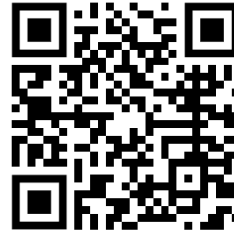

Healthy Snacks



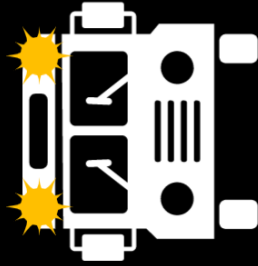

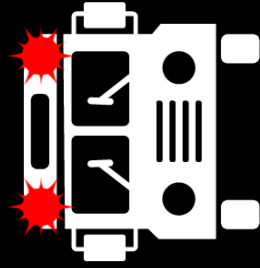
AMBER LIGHTS FLASHING? PREPARE TO STOP



The bus is preparing to stop and the red lights will soon begin flashing.

Vehicles coming from the either direction must be ready to stop. Use CAUTION when passing a bus that has flashing amber lights.

RED LIGHTS FLASHING? NO PASSING!



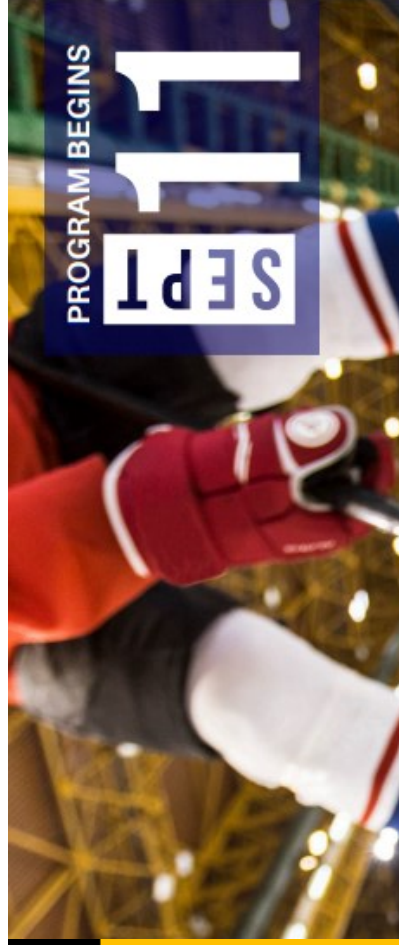
STOP 4-5 car lengths (20m) from the bus. An extended STOP SIGN means students are entering/exiting the bus.

Be alert for children crossing the roadway. Remain stopped until the flashing red lights are off and the stop sign is no longer extended.
