


## 2024-25 ECS Orientation

## School Volunteers-Field Trips

We appreciate parent volunteers who assist with field trips. **Vulnerable Sector Checks** and **Intervention Record Checks** are required for school volunteers (including parents) **IF** they have unsupervised access to students at any time during the field trip. Vulnerable Sector Checks can be done in the Mackenzie County office in La Crete. Intervention Record Checks (IRC) need to be requested via email. The application forms for IRC requests can be found on the FVSD website or picked up in the office at BHPS. Once completed, the IRC application, along with two pieces of ID, need to be emailed to: <a href="mailto:cs.hladmin@gov.ab.ca">cs.hladmin@gov.ab.ca</a>. Parents that will continuously be part of the whole group throughout the field trip do not require these checks to be completed.
