FVSD Jr. High Track and Field Divisionals and Zones Report

Jr. High students participated in the divisional track and field meet in High Level on Thursday, May 23. We had a total of 15 students participate in the event. The team finished in first place amongst all Jr. High Schools in the division. Avery Neudorf finished as the top female participant in Jr. High. Thank you to our Bisons students as they represented the school very well.

The team headed off to Grande Prairie for the zone track meet on May 31-June 1, and 11 students participated. BHPS finished in 10th place out of 60 teams, winning several individual medals (Scott Goertzen-1st in triple jump, Kyler Wieler-1st in triple jump, Luke Wiens- 2nd in 200m, Curtis Peters- 2nd triple jump, Avery Neudorf- 3rd 400m). The grade 7 boys won 3rd in the 4x100m, while Kyler Wieler aided LCPS in winning the 4x100m as well. All in all, students performed exceptionally well and represented BHPS positively.

- 4. Minutes from Previous Meeting Katharine read the April 29, 2024, meeting minutes.

6. Chairperson's Report

Pole shelter building to start on Wednesday, May 29, 2024, weather permitting. Junior high boys will be helping Larry Goertzen with this project to support school and community activities.

7. Principal's Report

- a. Danielle Goertzen has applied for the BHPS scholarship, council members approved this.
- b. BHPS enrollment- currently at 269 students, 13 grade 9 students leaving, 33 ECS students enrolled, 9 new students enrolled, 2 leaving, so that puts our projected student numbers at 295 students for 2024-25 school year.
- c. School expansion blueprint was reviewed by council members. Suggestions were made that Mr. Fehr will communicate to FVSD maintenance.
- d. Class lists and Parent meeting requests occurred on May 23, 2024, as per communication in newsletters.
- e. A bus is being provided to BHCS for local students choosing to go to high school. No other students except BHPS high school students will be on this bus.
- f. BHPS has 13 grade 9 students, 11 of them have confirmed to go on to high school whether it is at LCPS, BHCS or Pathways.
- g. Grade 9 Farewell and grade 9 trip both happening on Friday June 7, 2024. Ms. Haag will be taking the students to the Heimstaed Lodge in La Crete and to High Level to the games room and for a meal. Farewell will consist of supper and a ceremony to recognize grade 9 students for their time and efforts at BHPS.
- h. Junior high campout is planned for Friday, June 14, 2024. Students who achieved all requirements of the incentive program are allowed to participate.
- i. Collegiate Programming happening at BHPS next school year instead of LCPS. Mr. Kenyon, Mr. Goertzen, Mrs. Shannon Peters and some Educational Assistants will be leading this. BHPS plans to offer Babysitting courses, woodworking, construction, cooking, learners/drivers, among a host of other options. Planning is currently underway. Some concerns were raised about space, teaching staff, and how this will all work. Staff continue to plan in order to have this ready for September.

• Operational and SGF Budget Review- We are in good shape with our budgets and anticipate a small surplus.
