- 1. Call to order at 7:04 pm
- 2. Approval of Agenda
- 3. M/S Frank/Ryan that agenda was approved. Carried
- 4. Minutes from previous meeting January 27, 2025, were read by Maria Wieler.
- 5. Approval of previous minutes M/S Tim/Ryan that the January 27, 2025, minutes be accepted as presented. Carried

6. Chairperson's Report

Larry Goertzen had been in contact with Bruce Harder about the upcoming school expansion. It sounded as though things were on track regarding the classroom being built for our school. Just waiting for the provincial budget. Mr. Goertzen informed the council that the expansion was 90% approved and that the FVSD was considering building a second classroom as well due to cost savings. Will depend on the budget.

7. Principal Report

- Thank you to Nellie Friesen, Joyce Harder, Debbie Neufeld and Neta Loewen for proving the school council meal for the staff this Month. Thank you to all parents that randomly bring treats and food in for staff as well. This is appreciated immensely!
- <u>Update on Caleb Teichroeb</u>: As reported from the Teichroeb Family, the results of the last test looked good and as of now he is done with treatments which is very good news. Caleb was able to ring his bell at the Stollery, indicating he was done with treatments.
- There will be a presentation about drugs/alcohol, vaping led by Leah Martens in Junior high on March 20th in Junior High, Students will require Parent Consent to attend this presentation. This presentation was requested by BHPS parents and is supported by BHPS school council parents
- <u>Staffing Update</u>:
 - Mrs. Pam Boese will be teaching in grade 3 with Mrs. Peters until May 2nd, we are trying to get a qualified teacher to come in to finish the remainder of the year after she's done.
 - Mrs. Keefe is planning on coming back to Grade 1 next month. It has worked really well having Mrs. Schellenberg in her classroom while she was gone.
- Horizon student leadership conference will happen on March 3rd. Junior high student council leaders will be attending this event with Mrs. Neudorf who will be the staff leader.

- Parent and Teacher interviews will take place on March 5-6 with 10-minute time slots again this time. Parents may request a second time slot if they feel they require more than 10 minutes.
- FVSD has asked that all schools establish a debate club. This will be organized for junior high students by Mr. Kenyon, Mr. Diver, and Mr. Fehr. It is anticipated that there will be a divisional debate challenge at some point this year.
- There will be a Ski/Snowboarding trip coming up for the junior highs on March 11th. There is going to be a \$20 fee. Half will be paid by the school, and the rest will need to be paid by the student. School staff will observe how this event goes for students at the junior high age level and if it seems safe, taking grade 4-6 students will be considered as well.
- 8. Financial update:
 - Budget review: we are on track and in line with previous years spending.
- 9. Trustee report: Trustee not present.
