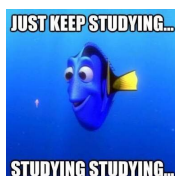
Thank you for your continued support and commitment to our school community. I look forward to seeing you all refreshed after break for the last weeks of school.

Term 3 Courses for Sr. High

Senior high term 3 begins April 28. Students will have the opportunity to explore two different career paths, in two, three week segments or take one six week course. We are excited to be able to offer our students these opportunities as they think about what career path they wish to have post secondary. Some of our exciting course offerings are listed below:

Carpentry:

Students will spend six weeks working through courses that meet first year apprenticeship requirements with practical hands on experience.

Culinary Arts:

A three week exploratory course, students will work out of the new culinary kitchen, developing new skills and providing goodies every week for sale out of the canteen.

Office Admin:

A three week exploratory course, students will gain foundational knowledge in Microsoft Programs and basic accounting skills

SIMS:

A three week exploratory course, students will gain experience running heavy equipment. Students will complete a series of safety certificates in order to access the Heavy Equipment Operator II course in the future.
